Early Years Pupil Premium (Nursery)



Our Pupil Premium funding is used to remove barriers to learning for EY Pupil Premium learners and diminish the differences between EY Pupil Premium learners and non- EY Pupil Premium learners. Our Funding supports all different aspects of school life.

A summary of aims for our Pupil Premium learners this academic year, based on addressing their barriers to educational achievement:

- To improve attendance and punctuality of EYPP learners to be in line or above the attendance of non – EYPP learners
- To ensure the provision in place for EYPP learners’ results in at least expected progress and attainment for EYPP learners
- To accelerate progress through the use of targeted intervention
- To ensure the wellbeing of EYPP learners is supported
- To promote access to activities to enrich EYPP learners’ school life and experiences (inc. workshops, trips and PTA events)
- To offer support to families of EYPP learners, where necessary
- To promote home learning for our EYPP learners
- To promote opportunities that could have a positive effect on EY PP learners’ future adult lives
- To promote equal opportunities for our EYPP learners by providing fully funded school uniform for EYPP learners
- To be supported by the non class based INCO
- To provide the opportunity to make use of the school Family Support Worker
- To provide targeted intervention for our EYPP children, delivered by the nursery Teaching Assistants
