English

Stories with Predictable Phrasing, Recounts, Labels, Lists and Captions, Rhyming Couplets, Poetry – Vocabulary Building, Instructions, Take One Book

Reading Key Learning:

- Identifies the goals and motives of the main character

Mathematics

Number & Place Value, Addition & Subtraction, Money & Measures, Measure & Shape, Doubling & Halving Measures, Shape & Data

Mathematics Key Learning:

- Counts forwards and backwards to 100
- Counts, reads and writes numbers to 100 in numerals, 1-20 in words.
- Counts in multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s
- Identifies and represents numbers using objects and pictorial representations

Science: Animals Including Humans (Common Animals, Plants & Diets) Common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds & mammals), common carnivores, herbivores & omnivores, compare structure of common animals, body parts, senses

Computing: Let's Create (Create/eWorlds) Exploring digital texts using a range of devices & software

History: Guy Fawkes and why he is a key person in history

Geography: The weather and how it changes through the year

Religious Education: Human Responsibility and values – looking at how humans affect the world around us and how we look after others in our community.

Art and Design: Faces using Picasso as inspiration

Design and Technology: Moving objects leading to us making our own model play ground
