## English

Study Skills, Poetry – Vocabulary Skills, Debating, Take One Poet, Take One Book -Pig Heart Boy

### Reading Key Learning:

- Looks for evidence of how that affects characters' behaviour and/or plot development
- Retrieves information, referring to more than one place in the text, and where there is competing (distracting) information
- Uses a range of strategies to identify the meaning of new vocabulary

### Writing Key Learning:

- Uses devices to build cohesion within a paragraph
- Controls the length, pacing and detail in their writing
- Spells some Year 5/6 words correctly

## Mathematics

Geometry; Ratio & proportion; Algebra; Measurement; Addition, subtraction, multiplication and division; Statistics; Fractions (incl decimals & percentages); Problem solving, investigations and working mathematically

### Mathematics Key Learning:

- Solve addition and subtraction multi-step problems in contexts deciding which operations and methods to use and why
- Multiply and dividing fractions
- Calculate the area of parallelograms and triangles

**Science:** Electricity (Changing Circuits and Symbols)

**Computing:** Sound Works (Create soundscapes incorporating different contents, target work towards the needs of different audiences and gather feedback)

**Geography:** Mapping the Local Area (How the landscape is constantly changing and how this moving on can cause conflict)
